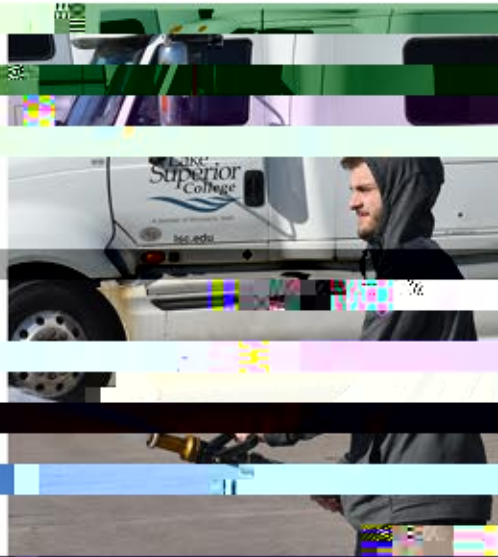

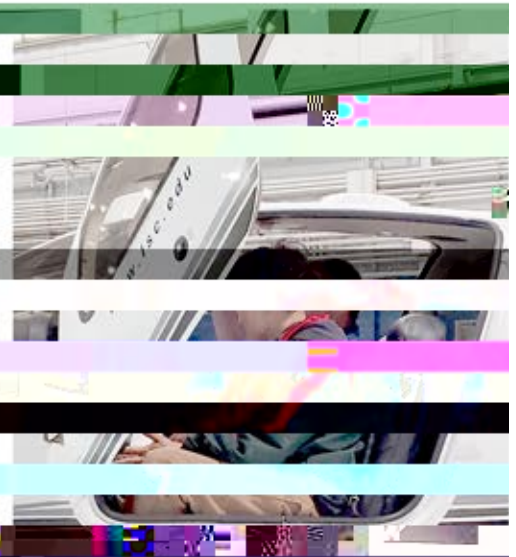

LSC's Downtown Center



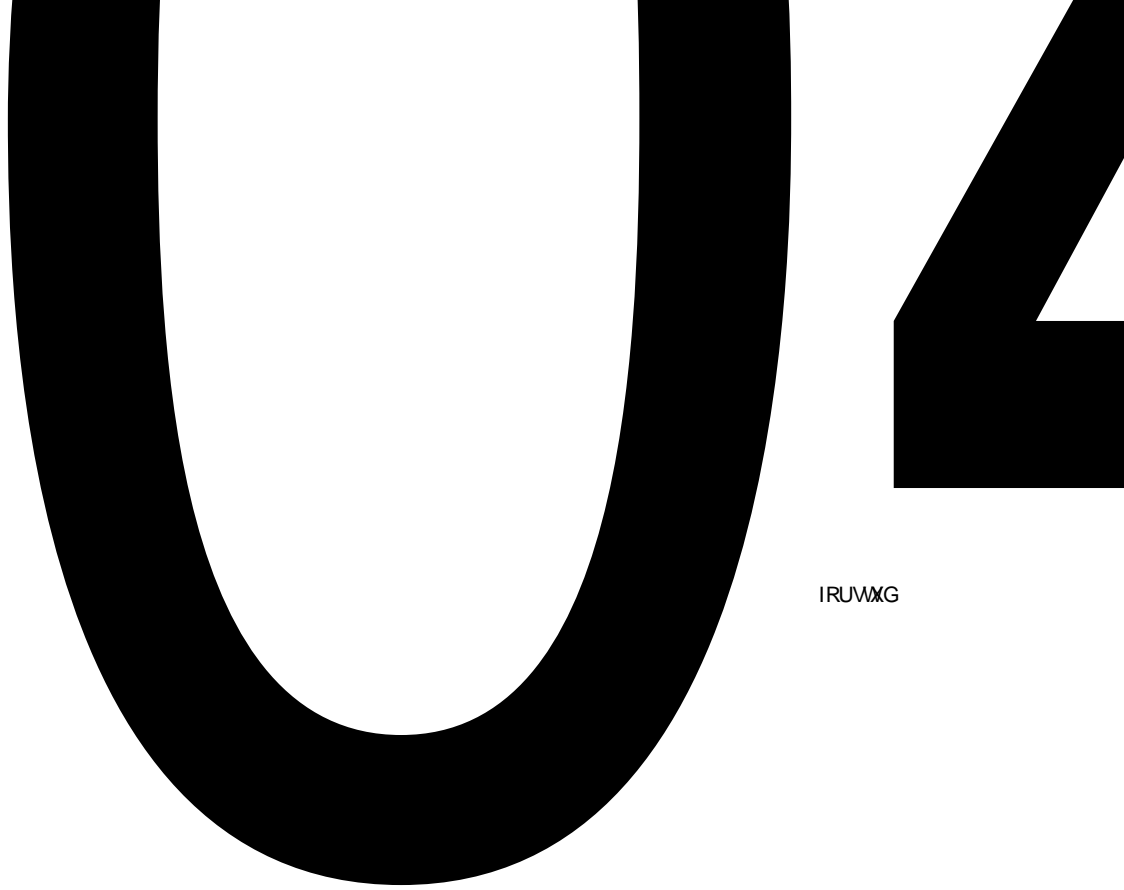
